Dear Klaus, dear Allan,

I have the pleasure to announce to you that based on the Accreditation Visit at the European Nazarene College (EUNC) conducted on February 10-12, 2020 by an ECTE VET panel (Rev. Horst Born; Dr. Karen Fulton) **the ECTE council decided to grant accreditation to the Advanced Diploma in Applied Theology (ADAT) and to renew the accreditation of the two following programmes offered by the school:**

- **Certificate in Spiritual Formation (CSF) - 60 ECTS;**
- **Diploma in Christian Ministry (DCM) - 120 ECTS.**

All of these programmes are being offered on a **distance learning basis**, with one central administrative unit at Linsengericht, Germany and Learning Centres located in continental Europe and the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS). The **accreditation is valid for five years (2020-2024)**. EUNC is at the end of this period advised to request a new visit and submit the necessary documentation.

Please, find attached a **‘Visitation Follow-Up’** document, which summarizes the requirements and recommendations articulated by the VET, specifies the decision by the council, and defines the follow-up procedures after the visit.

In order to foster quality enhancement in between two visits, the school is also requested to send after completion of each academic year (preferably in summer) an **Annual Progress Report (APR)**. For that purpose a form is available in the download area of the ECTE website. The first part is a statistical report on student figures; the second consists in a narrative report explaining how the requirements and recommendations listed in the “Visitation Follow-up Report(s)” attached to this letter are being implemented by the school.
