Re: ECTS calculation

Greetings from the EEAA Council!

The council in its Spring session 2017 took note of the letter sent to you on 24 January 2017 concerning the ECTS calculation. It reaffirmed that JETS needs to present a calculation of the credit counting according to ECTS – which, except error on our part, has not been communicated to us - and reiterates its initial concern:

*“... the requirement regarding the calculation of ECTS is not fulfilling the requirement spelled out in the VET report of 5th June 2014 which requires a **full course list with ECTS calculation of credits** [...] the required credit documentation must be submitted along with their next APR.”*

Despite several later requests the council still misses the above-mentioned course list with ECTS calculation of credits. In the European Higher Education Area, the ECTS credit reference is crucial as it allows for transfer of credits in-between institutions.

Please, be sure to include it in the Annual Progress Report due in Summer 2017. The Council will then in its Fall meeting take time to examine it and give you a feedback.
