Re: Decision by ECTE Accreditation Commission

Dear Imad and Colleagues:

allow me to share further details on the decision of the Accreditation Commission (AC) related to the requirement for your EQF Level 7/Second Cycle programmes.

Requirement #2: B.2.5 - Content, level, feasibility, and progression (all EQF Level 7 programmes)

That the research component in the programmes on Master level be strengthened following a clear progression in the assignments and especially in research papers in the final year to bring these programmes into conformity with ECTE standards and guidelines and the Dublin descriptors. See ECTE Standards and Guidelines, page 57 “Learning Outcomes” and EHEA Paris 2018 Communiqué.

JETS has achieved substantial compliance to B.2.5 in the design submitted (curricular maps).


The AC maintains the implementation of these adjustments as a recommendation. This means that ongoing reporting on implementation steps within each Annual Progress Report (APR) starting in 2024 is expected, including curricula for all EQF Level 7 programmes, and corresponding fully developed module descriptions.

As your next cyclical review must be completed by March 13, 2027, please contact me no later than spring of 2026 to start preparing for the next cyclical review.
